HPV (Human Papilloma Virus Infection)

What is HPV Infection?

- <u>HPV Infection</u> is a STD/Sexually Transmitted Disease, caused by human papillomavirus/HPV
- <u>HPV</u> the name of a group of viruses that include more than 100 different strains or types; more than 30 viruses are sexually transmitted; can infect the genital area of women and men including the skin of the penis, anus, vulva, cervix, rectum and linings of the vagina
- <u>Infected Person</u> usually have no symptoms and clears up on its own

Signs and Symptoms

- Often No Symptoms- usually goes away on its own without causing any serious health problems
- <u>Genital Warts</u>- painless, can be flat and raised, single or in groups, small or large, may grow in size and number or may go away
- <u>Cervical Cancer</u>- no symptoms unless advanced, important to screen regularly for cervical cancer
- <u>Less Common HPV-related Cancers</u> cancers of the vulva, vagina, anus and penis may not have signs and symptoms until advanced

Information

- Most Common Sexually Transmitted Virus in the United States at least 50% of sexually people will have HPV some time in their lives
- <u>Passed on</u>- through genital contact (vaginal or anal sex), you can pass to others without knowing it
- No Cure for HPV
- **Prevention** do not have sex
- Lowers your Chances- limit your partners, wear a condom
- **Does not Prevent HPV**-washing the genitals, urinating, douching after sex
